### **Research Question**

What conditions must be present within post-Soviet states to allow a sultanistic executive to develop?

# **Methodology and Variables**

Neopositivist Small-n Case Study

(Most Similar Case Comparison)

- DV: Sultanism -Present, Present with Limits, Not Present
- IV: Executive Military/Intelligence Experience -No Experience, Informal Experience, Formal Experience
- IV: Support of Societal Elites for the Executive -Supportive, Neutral, Antagonistic
- IV: Perception of economic conditions as time passes under the President's leadership -Better, the Same, Worse

- Georgian President Mikheil Saakashvili (2004-2013)
- Latvian President Vaira Vike-Freiberga (1999-2007)
- Russian President Vladimir Putin (2000-2008)
- Turkmen President Saparmurat Niyazov (1990-2006)

# •Perceived Economic Improvement -Support – Mil/Intel Experience $\neq$ Su

- •Mil/Intel Experience  $\neq$  Sultanism
- Mil/Intel Experience + Elite Support = S
- •Lack of Economic Improvement  $\neq$  Sulta
- Lack of Economic Improvement + Mil/I Experience + Elite Support = Sultanism

### **Findings on Sultanism**

-Necessary Condition: Moderate levels (or higher) of support for the executive from societal elites or the executive

-Sufficient Conditions: Elite support and improving economic conditions

-Executive military/intelligence experience is not a necessary condition
