RESEARCH QUESTION

How is German identity represented in discourses on refugees and asylum-seekers?

CONTEXT

- September 2015 • Angela Merkel declares open border policy for refugees and asylum-seekers coming to Germany
- February 2016 • Passage of Asylum Packet II – quicker deportation and restricted family migration
- May 2016 • Passage of Integration Act – easier access to job market, integration course requirement


METHODOLOGY



Discourse analysis to show constructions of German identity and how they relate to discourse on refugees and refugee policy


- Party platforms on asylum and integration
- Press releases making an argument about migration
- 3 months period before state parliament elections in March 2016 September 2016

DISCOURSES



- Refugees:
 - Deserving or undeserving?
 - Criminal, *Schützbedürftigen* (deserving of protection), humanitarian responsibility
- Identity:
 - Inclusive or exclusive?
 - *Leitkultur* (Grundordnung – basic law - and cultural identity)
 - Multiculturalism (Grundordnung and tolerance)


FINDINGS



ANALYSIS



Right wing extremism goes against basic law and democratic values



CONCLUSIONS

- Discourse on *Leitkultur* (leading culture) was present in more party discourses, and confined to the political right
- *Leitkultur* questions deservingness and promotes stricter integration procedures
- Tension between fear of nationalism and cultural heterogeneity
- Debate between different parties shows a healthy democracy
