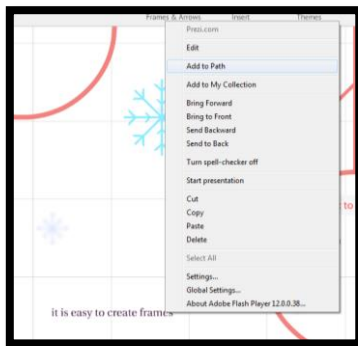
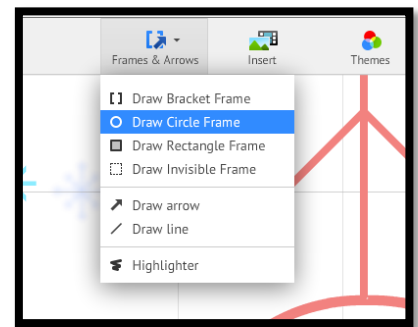

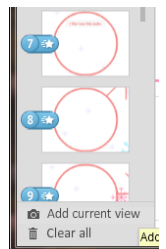
1 Three Ways to Create Frames

There are multiple ways to create frames, which help present the material in an orderly manner. The presentation content needs to be in a frame for a properly visible representation.

1. **Click on Frames and Arrows** on the top banner and select the frame you would like to use
2. After you have written a text anywhere on your canvas or imported the document/picture, **right click** (on the text or document) and select add to path. Your frame will be listed at the bottom of the path.



3. If you like the way your screen looks and wish that you had that view as a frame, you can click on **edit path**. At the bottom you will see **Add current view**. Clicking on this will give you the current view in an invisible frame at the bottom of your path. Don't forget to click **Done** at the right hand side when you are finished.

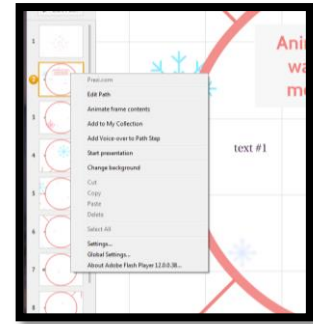


You can simply change the order of the frames by clicking on the frame you would like to move and placing it in the desired location in your path.

2 Animation

Animations are an easy way to convey your message differently and it can be done in three easy steps.

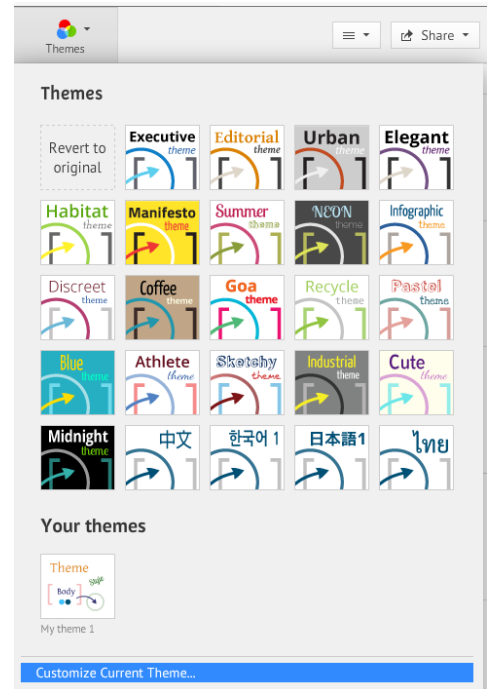
1. Right click on the frame you would like to animate. Click on **Animate Frame Contents**.
2. **Click on** the text and picture you would like to animate, in the order you would like them to appear in your frame. You will see a green star with a number appearing next to your text or picture.
3. **Click** on the play button at the top to see how the frame would look.
4. **Click DONE** when finished.



3 3D Background

3D Background provides depth to your presentation and is easy to do!

1. Click on **Themes** and select **Customize Current Theme**.
2. Click on **Advanced** on the left bottom corner
3. Click on **Edit** next to 3D Background
4. Click on **Upload** and select the image you would like to use as a background. When prompted about the image size, select **Keep original**.
5. Repeat step number four two times to get three different layers. You will see the different layers when you zoom in.

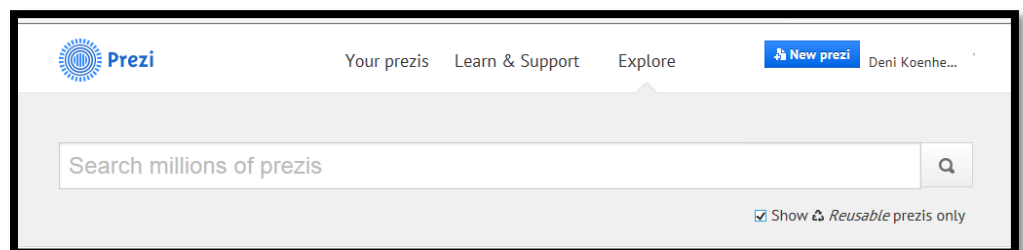


4 Poorly Constructed Prezi

Working on a poorly constructed Prezi allows you to improve your Prezi skills and observe commonly made mistakes.

In the main Prezi screen, click on **Explore** and find

Reusable Prezi's to work on by typing a common word in the search box. Click on the Prezi you would like to use and select **Make a copy** to start working on it.
